## **INFORMATION REGARDING 2010 SENIOR REP SELECTION PROCESS FOR STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS**

### **State Championship Teams**

KNA is seeking to enter teams in the 17 Years, 21 years, Opens and Over 35 Years State Championship Divisions. Teams will only be entered in a division if it is considered they will be competitive. It is most likely that all divisions will be paper graded. The Selection committee reserves the right to call a trial if there is an unusually large number of applications received/and or there are players whom the selectors have not viewed in recent State League, NID, State Championships or 2009 KNA Competition.

### **Selection Process**

#### **Selectors**

The senior rep selectors are Anne Margalit (Senior Rep Selection Convenor); Pat Ryan (life member); Joy Punch; Mandy Mortlock, Amanda Lee and Alison Punch (Reserve Selector). Each of these selectors were involved in the KNA 2010 State League selections, 2009 State Championships, and the 15's age group at the 2009 State Age championships and carnivals.

#### **Conflict of Interest**

Should any of the selectors have a daughter who is trialling this constitutes a conflict of interest, and accordingly they will not participate in any discussions or vote concerning their respective daughter's position in a team.

#### **Selection Criteria**

- All players will be selected on merit
- 10 - 12 players will be selected in each team.
- KNA By-Law 8 (a) (ix) states that "Any senior representative player with the exception of Night Interdistrict must be a current registered member of the Association"
- The Rep Committee has resolved "That no senior rep player will be entitled to play for another Association unless KNA was not fielding a team in their respective age division"
- Players eligible to play in the 17's division may be selected into the 21's division should there be insufficient numbers in the 21's division and there are surplus numbers in the 17's division. This selection decision in this instance will be based solely on merit
- Specific additional criteria includes experience, ability, commitment and attitude
- Team balance will be considered when making selections to ensure that each position has suitable coverage

#### **Selection Trials**

If necessary, selection trials for 17 and under will be held Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> March at The Brick Pit, Thornleigh. Players required for a trial will listed on the KNA Rep web page on Monday March 15<sup>th</sup>. Any player listed to trial who cannot attend will need to advise Anne Margalit (Senior Rep Convenor) by email or phone urgently on Monday March 15<sup>th</sup> (SL 7 and SL 8 players will already be in attendance for their normal training.)

If trials are required for any other age division – this will also be notified via the web page on Monday March 15<sup>th</sup>.

**WHAT FEES TO EXPECT IF YOU ARE CHOSEN IN A REPRESENTATIVE TEAM**

**Cost of Program:** all KNA players from Netta to A1 subsidize the cost of the representative program. Costs include coaching clinics, travel allowances, medical supplies, physiotherapist at carnivals, round robins, equipment, state age/champs accommodation, tents, meals, travel, fitness programs and court hire. All players in our representative programs both senior and junior are required to contribute towards these costs.

**Accommodation levy:** \$250

**Fundraising levy:** \$150 - KNA have agreed (in lieu of specific fund-raising by the players) a special levy per rep player. Payable once per year.

**State Championship Entry Fee:** \$50 (only if the player is not already playing State League in 2010)

**Uniform:** purchase of the specified uniform:

Bodysuit - Navy	\$150.00
Player jacket	\$80.00
Track pants	\$40.00
Training top	\$38.00
Polo top	\$38.00
Polar fleece	\$40.00
Socks	\$10.00
Sports Bags	\$35.00

**Note: These fees are an indication of possible charges only, and may be adjusted where necessary.**

**2010 Fees**

All outstanding monies for 2010, including KNA fees, uniforms and other items invoiced by KNA during 2009 must be paid in full prior to the nomination form and application being accepted. No players will be allowed to play in the Representative Trials until payments are received.

## **KNA SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE PLAYER COMMITMENT (2009 SEASON)**

### **KNA Mission Statement**

To continually develop KNA as a premier netball association through the provision of leading edge representative programs, which develops talent, fosters teamwork and encourages the pursuit of personal excellence. KNA has a commitment to ensuring that our player "loyalty" policy is adhered to wherever practical and all decisions concerning each player will be made with the KNA Mission Statement and this policy as the priority.

### **KNA Player Mission Statement**

To represent our Association and my team to the best of my ability and ensuring that the ideals of netball - participation, fitness, competition, teamwork and, above all, sportsmanship are always maintained.

### **Representative Commitments**

Representative players not only make a commitment to KNA, but just as importantly they make a commitment to the rest of their team. Absences from training, games and any representative functions (other than those absences that cannot be avoided) are unfair to the team, KNA and those players who were not fortunate enough to be selected in a representative team.

It is expected that all KNA senior representative players selected meet the following commitments:-

- Attendance at each game. Players should attend games even when injured to support their team
- Attendance at each of the scheduled training sessions (as required)
- Attendance at any organised training games as appropriate
- Attendance at NNSW presentation ceremonies held during respective Championships or Competitions
- Hold a current pass in the Umpires Theory Exam

The KNA policy requires that no representative player selected shall play for another Association at representative level during the season with the exception of NNSW, NSWIS, AIS and Netball Australia representative teams. Senior Representative players may seek permission to play in State Championships for another association only if KNA is not entering a team in their respective age division. It is most likely that all divisions will be paper graded.

Failure to meet the above Representative Commitments may lead to the player being withdrawn from their representative team on the recommendation of the KNA Representative Committee and at the sole discretion of the KNA Executive.

### **Player Code of Conduct**

It should always be remembered that you are representing KNA at all times whilst playing matches, attending carnivals, and visiting other Associations. KNA has a strict code of conduct that we expect our players to adhere to, and any deviations from this conduct will not be accepted. Whilst we wish all players to really enjoy their representative experience, it is also important that we do so whilst respecting those around us.

Failure to maintain the expected Player Conduct of Conduct may lead to the player being withdrawn from their representative team on the recommendation of the KNA Representative Committee and at the sole discretion of the KNA Executive.

### **Representative Player Commitment**

I/We have read and understand the Commitments and Code of Conduct that appear above and agree to meet these commitments. I/We accept the KNA Representative Committee policy that all players selected into a KNA representative squad do so on the understanding that they will withdraw from any conflicting representative programmes conducted by another Association upon acceptance of their selection into a KNA representative squad. I/We understand that we may be withdrawn from the KNA representative programme on the recommendation of the KNA Representative Committee and at the sole discretion of the KNA Executive should we not adhere to any of the above Commitments, Code of Conduct and Representative Committee Policy without satisfactory written explanation
