To continually develop KNA as a premier netball association through the provision of leading edge representative programs, which develops talent, fosters teamwork and encourages the pursuit of personal and team excellence.

Selection Process

Selectors

The Senior Rep Selection Convener, the Head Selector along with Senior Selectors will form the selection panel. The team coach/s will also be part of the selection panel if appointed prior to selections.

Selection Information

- Players must attend all trials if held. Players unable to attend all trials must apply in writing as mentioned previously.
- Playing in previous year/s Metro League, Summer Series, State Championships or Representative season competitions does not guarantee selection into a Senior State Titles team the following season/s.
- KNA has a player “loyalty” policy for all teams. Whilst KNA is willing to accept players from other Districts, such selection will be dependent upon the standard of those players as compared to the current KNA players and the team balance. Preference will always be given to current KNA players in circumstances whereby the players are judged to be equal in ability.
- The team selections will not be based entirely on the selection trials if held, but also on performances this season at Metro League, Summer Series (if applicable) and State Titles.
- The selectors will base their decisions on their own observations, coach’s reports and consideration of future development of players. Experience, ability, commitment and attitude will be considered.
- Team balance will also be considered when making selections to ensure that each position has suitable coverage.
- The selection of teams may not be completed following the initial selection trials and may include other players who meet criteria as determined by the senior rep selection committee and appointed coach.
- All players will be advised by email of the outcome (i.e team offer or non-selection). All players offered a place are asked to email a reply within 48 hours of the team offer being made.
- Players who accept a team offer and then chose to trial at other Districts or do not withdraw from positions already obtained at other districts will have their accepted status changed to under review.

Conflict of Interest

Should any of the selectors have a relative who is trialing this constitutes a conflict of interest, and accordingly they will not participate in any discussions or vote concerning their respective relatives position in a team.

Player Code of Behaviour

Whilst we wish all players to really enjoy their representative experience, it is also important that we do so whilst respecting those around us. Failure to maintain the expected Player Code of Behaviour may lead to the player being withdrawn from their representative team on the recommendation of the KNA Representative Committee and at the discretion of the KNA Executive.
