KNA Spring Competition 2023 Borrowing Guidelines



If clarification is required, please check with the Competition Supervisor on duty. Penalties for incorrect borrowing exist and may apply.

LATE REGISTRATIONS

• All late registrations must be submitted in writing for approval by the grading committee at **least 24 hours prior to playing.**

ALL COMPETITIONS

- Interclub borrowing is permitted. (ie. any club can borrow from any other club)
- Borrowed players cannot displace an existing team member.
- A player may be borrowed any number of times.
- Permission must be sought from the Competition Supervisor on duty if borrowing across the grade.
- Specific restrictions apply to some competitions also, please check below.

JUNIOR COMPETITION

• Players may NOT be borrowed outside of their age group.

9/10 Years Grades

· Teams may only borrow as follows:

9/10 years	Permitted
Division 1	Across the grade, Div 2, Div 3 & Div 4
Division 2	Across the grade, Div 3 & Div 4
Division 3	Across the grade & Div 4
Division 4	Across the grade

11/12 Years Grades

· Teams may only borrow as follows:

11/12 years	Permitted
Division 1	Across the grade, Div 2, Div 3
Division 2	Across the grade, Div 3
Division 3	Across the grade

LADIES COMPETITION

Players are NOT permitted to be borrowed from Mixed Competition

Teams may only borrow as follows:

Ladies Comp	Permitted
Division 1/2	Across the grade, Div3/4, Div 5, Div 6 & Div 7
Division 3/4	Across the grade, Div 5, Div 6 & Div 7
Division 5	Across the grade, Div 6 & Div 7
Division 6	Across the grade & Div 7
Division 7	Across the grade

MIXED COMPETITION

- Borrowing of both male and female players is allowed.
- Players are **NOT permitted** to be borrowed from the **Ladies Competition**.
- Players are **NOT permitted** to be borrowed from the **Junior Competition**.
- Written Parental permission must be supplied, and approval gained from the
 Competition Supervisor on duty for 14-year-olds to play in Mixed Cadets prior to
 taking the court. Permission is to be written onto or attached to score sheet with
 signature of parent/guardian. Parents/guardians should discuss safety aspects with
 Competition Supervisor on duty prior to play.
- Written Parental permission must be supplied, and approval gained from the
 Competition Supervisor on duty for 17-year-olds to play in Mixed Seniors prior to
 taking the court. Permission is to be written onto or attached to score sheet with
 signature of parent/guardian. Parents/guardians should discuss safety aspects with
 Competition Supervisor on duty prior to play.

Teams may only borrow as follows:

Mixed Comp	Permitted
Senior Division 1	Across the grade, Div 2, Div 3, ONLY 17-year-olds (birth year 2006) from Cadets with permission as per above.
Senior Division 2	Across the grade, Div 3, ONLY 17-year-olds (birth year 2006) from Cadets with permission as per above
Senior Division 3	Across the grade, ONLY 17-year-olds (birth year 2006) from Cadets with permission as per above
Cadets	Across the grade, ONLY 14-year-olds (birth year 2009) from Inters with permission as per above
Inters 1	Across the grade & Inter 2
Inters 2	Across the grade
