



SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE SELECTOR

STATUS: COMMITTEE MEMBER

QUALIFICATIONS: **Of Greatest Benefit (Preference)**
Previous recent experience in grading/selector at club level
Previous recent experience in coaching netball teams at club level

Beneficial

Level 1 Coaching Accreditation (now Development).
Current Section 1 Theory pass
Previous recent experience as a selector at either Junior or Senior Rep level
Previous recent experience as a Junior or Senior Rep coach

"The Senior Rep Selection Committee shall consist of five (5) voting members being the Senior Rep Selection Convenor, three (3) appointed Senior Selectors and the coach of the relevant team. No member of the Senior Rep Selection Committee will be eligible to be a member of the Rep Appointments Panel.

- (i) The Senior Rep Selection Convenor shall have a casting vote (if necessary) as long as there is no conflict of interest.*
- (ii) The appointed Senior Selectors will be required to have sufficient qualifications and experience to hold this position and will be appointed by the Senior Rep Selection Convenor after endorsement from the KNA Executive.*

Not more than two-fifths of any sub-committee shall be members of any one affiliated or non-affiliated club with the exception of the following committees: -

- (i) Invited Senior Rep Selectin Committee, which mainly comprise of members of the KNA Club.*
- (ii) No member of the Rep Committee or Rep Selectin panels will be eligible to be a member of the Rep Appointments Panel.*

DUTIES AS LISTED IN BY LAWS:

The Duties of the Senior Rep Selection Committee are:

- (i) to select Netball NSW Metro and Night Interdistrict teams and*

(ii) to select teams for each division to compete at the State Championships.”

RESPONSIBILITIES RE ABOVE DUTIES:

To select a minimum of nine (9) players for each division to compete at the State Championships.

To select State League and Night Interdistrict teams.

Attend meeting convened by Rep Selection Convenor to establish the strategies for the Senior Rep Selection programme for the coming year.

Become an active member of the Senior Rep Selection Committee for the season.

Attend selection meetings throughout the representative season as and when necessary.

Attend all selection trials as set down in the Senior Representative Teams calendar to select teams to represent KNA at State Championships.

Ensure satisfactory recent knowledge of each of the players trying out for selection by having watched senior players at both club and representative level or through discussions with the other members of the Senior Selection Panel.

If possible, attend at least one (1) pre-State Championship carnival as required.

If possible, attend at least one (1) day at the State Championships to monitor the progress of the players to select teams to represent KNA in the State League, Regional Interdistrict and Night Interdistrict competitions.

Ensure satisfactory recent knowledge of each of the players trying out for selection by having watched senior players at both club and representative level or through discussions with the other members of the Senior Selection Panel.

If possible, attend at least one (1) game for each respective senior Representative teams throughout the season to monitor the progress of the players.

If possible, attend at least one (1) training session for each respective senior Representative teams to monitor the progress of the players.

If possible, attend at least one (1) day at the State Age Championships and one (1) junior rep carnival or two (2) games at Canoon in the A1 or A2 grade to observe the current 15-year age group players who will be progressing to the senior age group later that season.

Office Bearers are required to endeavour to attend Special General Meetings and the Annual General Meeting as listed in the calendar to ensure there is always a quorum as required under the Constitution.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Declare any potential conflict of interest in accordance with the Rep Committee resolution as follows: -

“The Rep Committee resolved that each specific rep committee (selection committees, appointments panels) must include as a standard agenda item “Conflicts of Interest” to be tabled and minuted and to ensure that such conflict is then handled in such a manner so as to not affect the workings of that committee”

Advise the Rep Selection Convenor of any matters that the selector feels should be brought to the Convenor’s attention.

If possible, attend sufficient club games on Saturday’s at Canoon Road courts to monitor progress of players already playing representative level, and to become aware of any potential representative players in KNA who are not at present playing representative netball.

Attend to any other Representative related tasks that may be relevant to the improvement of the KNA Representative programme.
