



## **WET WEATHER COMMITTEE – GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES**

**STATUS:** COMMITTEE MEMBER

*“The Wet Weather Committee shall consist of three (3) members: including an Executive Committee member, a member of Umpires Committee and a member of Grounds Committee.”*

### **DUTIES AS LISTED IN BY LAWS:**

*“The Duties of Members of the Wet Weather Committee of the Association are:*

- (i) To make decisions on play including:
  - a. Cancelling full days.*
  - b. Cancelling the first two (2) time slots; depending on the forecast, the playing position to be reviewed an hour and a half before each following time slot.**
- (ii) To notify decisions in relation to wet weather play to the following
  - a. Grounds Convenor.*
  - b. Club on grounds duty.*
  - c. Canteen Supervisor and any other relevant people.*
  - d. All electronic and relevant telephone recording.”**

### **RESPONSIBILITIES RE ABOVE DUTIES:**

Keeping in mind the decisions made by Council with respect to the wet weather conditions if a decision is called on before the start of any games liaise with all members to make an informed decision on whether to cancel play for the entire day or whether to cancel the first two time slots and reassess the conditions later.

If games have started and wet weather sets in inspect the grounds and then decide as to whether the games for the rest of the day will be cancelled or whether two (2) time slots will be cancelled, and another decision made approximately 1 hour before the start of the time slots still listed to be played.
