E) OPEN DIVISIONS

- (1) Players who are $\frac{17}{1}$ years of age and over by $\frac{31 \text{ December}}{1}$ in the year of play are eligible to play in this Division.
- (2) Open teams may have a <u>maximum of 2</u> registered players who are aged <u>16</u> <u>years</u> by <u>31 December</u> in the year of play.
- (3) Players turning 15 years by <u>31 December</u> in the year of play are to play in the Cadet division.
- (4) KNA 15 Year Representative teams may be considered to play in the Open Division, at the invitation of the grading committee or by team request and approval by the grading committee. They will be required to play all competition rounds but will not be eligible for the final series.

In order to strengthen the Cadet division, the grading committee (based on comments from clubs) are proposing that all 15-year-olds (in the year of play) remain in Cadets. 15-year-olds will not be eligible to play in Opens.

KNA's 15-year Rep teams will be eligible to play in the Opens division by invitation from the Grading Committee or request by Rep Committee and approval by Grading Committee.

By maintaining these players, we will strengthen the Cadet division.

Concerns were raised over the ability to keep players and the standard of play after State Championships are held, with many players losing interest in playing the all the remaining competition rounds.

After much discussion from Stuart Moore, Louise Woods, Andrew Larratt, Melissa Costa, Peta Stewart, Mick Flarey, Kissane Gray and members of the Grading Committee, it was decided to replace the above Motion with the following:

a. Item from Lindfield Netball Club

Kur-ring-gai Council has just announced the Recreational Needs Study which will directly impact Netball facilities in the future.

Time is of the essence as submissions need to be in by 5pm 27th July 2022.

We want to present the background to this at the meeting so that we can get as many responses as possible from all netballers.

We were informed that if no (or not enough) action was taken at this stage we would possibly LOSE some of the facilities we currently have. It is CRITICAL that this is done, otherwise nothing will change.
