“The Grading Committee shall consist of a maximum of six (6) members including the Grading Convenor, and will only have one representative per affiliated or non-affiliated club.”

DUTIES AS LISTED IN BY LAWS:

“The Duties of the Grading Committee members of the Association are:

- (i) The paper grading of teams for Winter & Spring competitions.*
- (ii) The physical grading of teams where necessary e.g., pre-season 9 Years Grading*
- (iii) The clearing of players to register in a team after initial grading of that team.*
- (iv) The setting of borrowing guidelines at the commencements of the competition year.*
- (v) Recommendations for regrading for the day competition.”*

RESPONSIBILITIES RE ABOVE DUTIES:

Attend meetings convened by the Grading Convenor to discuss plan of action for the year ahead.

In conjunction with the Grading Convenor and once all clubs' teams and proposed grades are received do paper grading of all teams entered in the competition.

When requested assist the Grading Convenor in arranging and holding physical grading.

When required help clubs with their grading.

Be available to assist with any grading disputes that may arise.

Attend a regrading meeting if required.

Assist the Grading Convenor in notifying all clubs involved in or requesting regrading of the outcome of this specific meeting.

When requested assist the Grading Convenor in arranging and holding physical grading.

Assist in managing the Representative Transfer Policy with the KNA Grading Convenor and KNA Jnr. Rep Selection Convenor

Assist the Grading Convenor in the clearing of players to register in a team after initial grading of that team has been done.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Once committee members have been assigned clubs, they are the contact point to help these clubs if they are having grading problems.

Be available to answer any grading issues that may arise throughout the season.

Bring to the notice of the Grading Convenor any contentious issues that may arise with respect to all aspects of grading.

Time permitting; during the season try to watch those teams that the committee felt they had problems grading into the appropriate grade.

Assist the Grading Convenor wherever possible when requested during the season.
