Andrew Larratt WAH - advised that Wahroonga had had to employ someone for Covid role (Spring Competition). Asked why it couldn't be a user pay with a levy? We should employ people to do this job.

IE – how many other clubs had to do this?

Don Tritton Kissing Point - advised that they didn't have to pay anyone.

Tatjana Domazet - advised Wahroonga was the only club who had paid. We could charge everyone \$5 or whatever so we could have someone to cover nights?

AL– couldn't find any volunteers and perhaps we look at in the future.

JP – suggested we can discuss options further at the Competition Forum in 2021.

Question Rhonda Dekker WP – outline re building levy and what it will be used for in the future

JP – part of the executive plan concept was for KNA to have a new complex, which we would need 1 to 2 million dollars. At this stage no indoor facility will ever be permitted on this site, but an alternate site may come up in future that we can support with funding. Levy would still be retained so we could work towards having a new complex at Canoon Rd or any major works as deemed appropriate over long term future. We currently obtain around \$38,000 maximum per annum in revenue, so it is a long term strategy required to ensure the future of KNA. Upgrades of some sites may also be required at our cost

Giselle Stollznow – advised later in the season would suit West Pymble better.

KB (Fixtures) – advised re spring comp:

Having the spring comp later in December can be problematic; one, is it gets hot and secondly December is a busy month for people. We do tend to have, going into December, the likelihood of more teams forfeiting on the tail end of the competition. That's why we like spring comp to finish end of November.

Tatjana Domazet (Spring comp Convenor) – issue with last weeks of November when schoolies is on – preference to finish late November would be preferable.

JP (Chair) – Spring competition comments noted. Suggestions we have an overlap with final series at Canoon ?

TD – no support for second week of December finish.

Stuart Moore - moving night comp forward shouldn't create much of a problem to overlap.

JP – 5th calendar would have to varied with Spring competition coming forward two **weeks**.

KB – that won't be a problem.

DT – all ok.

JP – asked Kissing Point if they are happy to vary their proposed Option 5. Agreed by Don on their behalf.

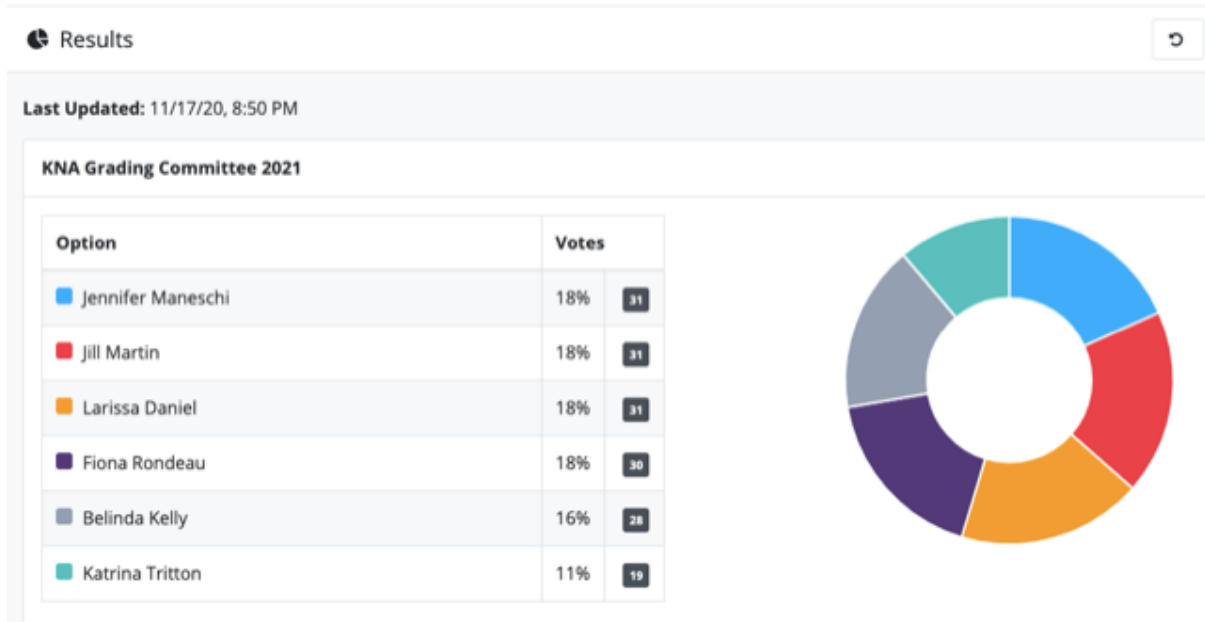
