*“The Umpires Committee shall consist of fifteen (15) members including Umpires Convenor. Where possible, members of the Umpires Committee are to hold an AANA or Association badge.”*

**DUTIES AS LISTED IN BY LAWS:**

“The Duties of the Umpires Committee are:

- (i) to be responsible for all umpiring matters relating to the Association.
- (ii) to carry out any umpiring functions as may be directed by the Council and to ensure that reports on all activities, decisions etc. are conveyed to each Council Meeting.
- (iii) to roster umpires for competition games as required.
- (iv) to list and select umpires for Carnivals and Inter Association matches.
- (v) to deal with requests for use of umpires outside the Association.
- (vi) to be responsible for assessing Junior and Senior Umpires and if required arrange badging panels for same.
- (vii) to supply one member of the Umpires Committee to the Wet Weather and Fixtures Committees.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES RE ABOVE DUTIES:**

Once a committee member is allocated with a specific portfolio ensure that all requirements in respect to that portfolio are carried out and report any problems to the Convenor for assistance.

Assist the Umpire Convenor as required to:

- (i) Ensure all responsibilities with respect to umpiring matters are carried out in a timely and efficient manner.
- (ii) Ensure all presentations; training sessions, coaching days, etc. are carried out smoothly.
- (iii) Assist with the marking off of umpires and standby umpires on Saturdays during the competition
- (iv) Endeavour to attend Rep Carnivals, selections and training games to coach umpires as and when require.
- (v) If requested assist with updating the umpire's software throughout the season and especially during the final series.
- (vi) One Member of the committee is required to be a representative on the Wet Weather Committee to assist in making decisions on when to cancel competition games throughout the competition. This person must be available from very early in the morning throughout the entire day for consultation as and when required.
- (vii) Another member if required should be available to consult with the Fixtures committee

## **OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Each member of the Committee is requested to support each other and the convenor at all times.

Members of the Committee should, if asked, make themselves available to assist in the process of deciding on the recipients of the Junior Umpiring Awards.

All appropriate Members should make themselves available for umpiring during the final series and assisting with the presentations on Grand Final Day

Attend Post Season Meeting to close off any outstanding issues and start the thinking process for the next season.

Attend all Committee Meetings and especially the first meeting of the next season to set and finalise program for next season.

Help in any other way possible to ensure that the Umpiring Program and the Umpires in KNA are protected
