3. Community Grant Update

- a. Two grants have been won over the past month
 - i. \$3700 for a Migrant Outreach Program, and
 - ii. \$1600 for Small Equipment upgrades.

4. North Turramurra Update

a. NT seems to be back on track. HP stepped down as Secretary in July and NT is working towards a large increase in members registering for next year's Winter Competition.

5. Building Fund Panel update:

- **a.** RJ outlined the Soccer proposal at NTRA whereby they are building a new grandstand. RJ wants us to reach out to Soccer to see if we can partner with them and to have netball get something out of the proposal. Support should be given to all codes of sport as that can lead to a stronger position for us all with KMC. Ideally netball would like to see change rooms/meeting facilities and extra netball courts if possible.
- **b.** NT suggested that Councils work on a 5-year horizon, i.e. timeframe with it taking 2 years to get Bertha up and running. He suggests that you plan big to see what comes from that. He is directing the working committee.

- **i.** All players 16 and under, must play in their age group within their own Club, but can play in Seniors as an additional game with another Club (if required).
- **ii.** Minimum age for seniors is 16.
- **iii.** Allowing players to play in juniors and seniors rules and eligibility to be considered.
- iv. Transferring of clubs by rep players only by KNA approval
