DUTIES AS LISTED IN BY LAWS:

“The Duties of the Coaching Committee are:

- (i) to carry out any coaching functions as may be directed by the Coaching Administrator.*
- (ii) to ensure that reports on all courses are conveyed to Council Meetings.”*

RESPONSIBILITIES RE ABOVE DUTIES:

Be available when requested to answer any questions that may arise with respect to:

- availability of coaching material instruction days, demonstration days and courses
- available to club coaches throughout the season.

Assist the Coaching Administrator arrange and conduct demonstrations, instructions and coaching days arranged throughout the season.

Assist the Coaching Administrator in arranging and holding OTC and Level 1 coaching courses.

Assist with any paperwork that is required to ensure these courses are carried out and up-to-date records kept of attendees of various courses held throughout the season.

If requested by the Coaching Administrator help prepare reports on courses held during the season for the Executive and Council Meetings.

OTHER RESPONSIBILITIES:

Be available, to answer questions as required during the season.

Attend meetings called by the Coaching Administrator throughout the year.

Keep up to date with any new material and coaching procedures coming through from All Australia or Netball NSW that may assist our coaches improve their skills.

Any other duties that may be required or requested by the Coaching Administrator during the year.
