

## Junior Representative Commitment 2020-21

**With uncertainty remaining over what impact covid will have on the 2020-2021 Rep season the following information is a guide and will be updated throughout the season.**

Welcome to KNA and the nomination process for trialling. It is important that the following information be read by a parent or guardian of the player nominating and the box ticked indicating that they have understood and accepted the requirements and expectations set by KNA. This acceptance will then be held by KNA.

To play at representative level is an honour and a privilege. The commitment is not only made by the player but by their family due to the large time requirements and also in a financial sense. The most important commitment, however, is to the other members of the Rep team. Full participation is expected in the following areas;

- \*Selection trials – 2-6 sessions
- \*1-2 training sessions per week
- \*6-8 carnivals across the Greater Sydney Region
- \*Round robin events
- \*BBQ rosters – parents and players
- \*KNA functions

In the case of injury or in the event of absences that cannot be avoided, permission may be granted for leave. These commitments start in 2020 and run through the year until July 2021.

If selected for Junior State Titles attendance at the Junior State Titles (26<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021), including travel, staying away with the team and attendance at the NNSW presentation ceremonies is compulsory.

**Player Code of Conduct** is taken very seriously by KNA. As a representative of our Association, respect and fair play is paramount and failure to conform to our guidelines that are found under Library on the KNA website, will result in the player being withdrawn from the team.
